NOW WHAT HAPPENS?

Welcome to AYSO Region 51! Did you know that you have just joined the largest youth soccer club in the World? About 500,000 players across the nation are developing their skills in a fun, fair and safe environment. American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO) is a non-profit youth soccer organization founded in 1964. It is one of the few accredited youth organizations in the country. What makes us special is our dedication to providing a quality experience for youth. We base the things we do on six philosophies: **Everyone Plays, Balanced Teams, Open Registration, Positive Coaching, Good Sportsmanship & Player Development.** We welcome your family to our AYSO family!

To help make these philosophies a part of who we are, AYSO mandates training and certification for all volunteers. AYSO is the 1st youth organization to introduce Safe Haven which is a player & volunteer protection program. AYSO requires that all volunteers register each year. Background checks are now done on 100% of our volunteers.

Please Remember...

AYSO is a parent-based volunteer organization established to provide a positive experience for our children. Go to the games. Learn the rules. Above all, be tolerant of the children's coaches' and referees' mistakes and weaknesses. Get involved, volunteer!

What's the Board doing?

In June, our Region Board begins the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season. When this is completed, the uniforms will be ordered and the coaches will be notified.

When do the coaches get their teams?

Coaches will complete their trainings and should expect to receive their team rosters the first part of August at our coaches meeting.

When do the players get called?

Teams may begin training two weeks before the first game. The coaches will call the players after Aug 1 and sometime before Aug 15. Each coach sets his/her own training days, time and location.



It's after Aug 15, and my child has not been called. What do I do?

Please do not panic if you see teams training and your child has not been called. Not all teams begin training at the same time. Also some coaches may be out of town. If your child has not been called by *August 10*, you can log into ayso51.org and look up your coach's contact info. Or you may leave a message at (801)200-3865.

What else does my child need?

The registration fee includes: complete uniform (jersey, shorts, socks) & supplemental accident insurance. In addition, you may need to obtain shoes, shin guards (required), a soccer ball (size depends on age) and a water bottle.

How often are trainings and games?

Trainings are held once or twice a week depending on age (field and times to be determined by your child's coach). Games will be on Saturdays with the first game toward the end of August.

Refund?

Partial refunds may be issued after submitting a written request to aysoregion51@gmail.com. Refund requests must be approved by the Region 51 board. **After June 1st, no refunds will be issued.**

Late registration?

Late registration begins *June 1*. We will register players until all the teams are full, through *September 1*. Those interested may call (801)200-3865, or email aysoregistrar51@gmail.com.
